This year in April our prices are increasing with an average of 5.89% across all our products. The majority of this increase is on the hospital products with Complete Ancillary having only a 3% increase and Ancillary Lite with only a 1.6% increase.

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### Did you know.... Claiming Tips and Tricks

## Maximise your benefits when claiming Dental and Orthodontics

Dental and orthodontic claiming can be confusing. To explain it simply, if you have Complete Ancillary\* cover you can claim a maximum of \$3,600 in orthodontic benefits over your lifetime and \$1700 for dental each year (but the total benefit that will be paid in any calendar year for dental plus orthodontic is limited to \$1700).

To maximise claiming your benefits each year make sure you claim all dental items for the calendar year FIRST before claiming for orthodontic treatment. Your orthodontic benefits are the only benefits that can 'carry over' each year until the total benefit (ie 80% of the cost) has been paid or your lifetime limit of \$3600 has been reached.



Claim orthodontics in instalments using what's left of your dental limit each year, and then again the following year until you've reached your limit.

To help this process please provide a copy of the Orthodontic contract with your Orthodontist to the fund. If you need more clarification please give us a call and speak to our Claims Team.
