Practical Things to Remember This Time of Year



ACA Health benefits are paid on a Calendar Year period, so your annual limits finish on December 31 each year. Don't worry you have two years from the date of service to claim your benefits



Your benefits renew on the 1st of January each year.



Pay your contributions in advance to make sure you have cover over the Christmas Period.



Take out travel insurance if you are travelling overseas or domestically. To get your discount you must add your membership number. (if you have a 4 digit membership number you will need to add a zero (0) at the start to make up 5 characters).



If you are moving, or leaving an employer that pays your contribution through payroll please make arrangements to change your address and payment method online at acahealth.com.au



Dependants who are leaving study should start thinking about taking out cover as they may not be able to stay on your membership next year.



If you have a dependant that isn't studying and is between 21-30, we have an extension product for you to consider that allows them to remain on your membership.

Student Dependant Information

With a new tertiary year commencing in 2025, we want to ensure that your student dependants remain covered on your membership. If they are aged 21 to 24, they are eligible for coverage at no extra cost while they remain full-time students, do not have a spouse or de facto partner, and are financially dependent on you (i.e. earning less than \$20,000 per year).

If your child still qualifies as a student dependant follow these 5 easy steps to update your details:

- 1. Login to Online Member Services via www.acahealth.com.au
- 2. Select 'My Account' from the left-hand menu
- 3. Scroll down to 'Student Dependant Status'
- 4. Complete the fields and upload proof of student status for the new student year
- 5. Click 'Submit'

If your child no longer qualifies as a student dependant, but you would like to keep them on your membership, you may wish to add Dependant Extension Cover to your policy*. To do this:

- 1. Login to Online Member Services via www.acahealth.com.au
- 2. Select 'My Cover' from the left-hand menu
- 3. Under 'review your cover via quick quote' select a Family/Single Parent Gold Hospital and Ancillary combined product.
- 4. In the Dependant Extension menu choose 'yes'
- 5. Click 'Submit'
- 6. Review the quotes shown on the screen, at the bottom of your preferred quote click the 'Request change to this cover' button.

If your child no longer qualifies as a student dependant, and you do not wish to take out the Dependant Extension, your child can re-join ACA Health in their own right.

Pay with HICAPS

This new system integrates HICAPS claiming directly into the Specsavers website, streamlining the purchase and claiming process for contact lens wearers.

As Christians, we are called to care for the poor and feed the hungry, a mission echoed throughout the Bible with over 20 direct references. This profound commitment to service inspires both individuals and organisations to take action in their communities.

One such initiative making a positive impact in the Hornsby area is The Dish, a program that has been providing meals, companionship, and compassion to the vulnerable and less fortunate for the past 20 years. The individuals served by The Dish often face challenges such as financial hardship, unemployment, physical and mental health issues, addiction, or loneliness. Motivated by Jesus' love, the volunteers at The Dish strive to extend hope and kindness to those in need.

For nearly eight years, the staff at ACA Health have actively supported The Dish by donating dessert items. Every other month, staff members bring a variety of dessert items such as fresh fruit, dried and canned fruit, muesli bars, and cakes to the office for donation. These contributions are then taken across the road to the Sydney Adventist Hospital, where a volunteer group incorporates them into meals served at The Dish bi-monthly.

While there are many organisations who support similar programs through financial donations or designated volunteer days, ACA Health's initiative is driven and supported by ACA Health employee's personal contributions. Our employees volunteer to be rostered bi-monthly and bring in their donations personally. This hands-on approach creates a deeper, more meaningful impact. It fosters a sense of community engagement and personal investment among our staff.
