
Rather than cutting back on hospital cover and risking this tax penalty, we've created a new product, Mid Ancillary, as a smarter solution.

## **New July 2025 Rebate Tiers - Time to Review**

The Australian Government private health insurance rebate is aimed to assist with premium costs and encourage Australians to maintain private health coverage. This rebate is determined by income levels.

This year, the income thresholds for the rebate are set to rise. As a result, depending on your income, you may benefit from a higher rebate.

From 1 July 2025, the new income thresholds are as follows:

<sup>\*</sup>Single parents and couples (including de facto couples) are subject to family tiers. For families with children the Income thresholds are increased by \$1,500 for every child after the first.

## From the Fund Manager

Exercise can be quick, literally 30 minutes and you're done. I need an Exercise Scientist to push myself and it isn't like going to a gym.   - ensuring the services are provided according to the plan; and
  - monitoring the patient's compliance with the agreed goals and activities specified in the plan.

The winning educational resources are professionally printed and distributed to Adventist Primary Schools across Australia.




